As each member of staff is becoming better trained in how and when to use Tapestry, to ensure it is effective, we hope you are enjoying an increase in posts. With this in mind, we would like to share with you another Tapestry setting, which we have now enabled: 'push notifications'.

Push notifications mean you can now receive notifications to your phone or tablet telling you a new observation has been added for your child, a staff member has replied to a comment or message you've posted, or a new document has been made visible to you. We have also enabled push notifications at our end, so it is easier for us to see when you add an observation.
