Year 2 Summer Term 1 - 2021

Mathematics

Maths teaching will cover the following areas;

- ♦ Applying patterns
- ♦ Column method
- ♦ Formal multiplication
- Problem solving
- Fractions of Quantities
- Weight and Capacity
- ♦ Interpretations



Continual practise of number bonds and multiplication tables.

English

English teaching is split into three strands; sentence structure and spelling, text analysis and understanding of reading.



Sentence: Dictionary and thesaurus work. Apostrophes to show possession and contraction. Editing skills, rhyming words and rhyming patterns

Text: Comprehension skills, descriptions, poetry and story planning and writing.

Comprehension: Poetry from various poets including performance poetry by Michael Rosen.

Science

This half term we will be looking at 'Growing Up and Keeping Healthy.'

Over the coming weeks we will be able to:-

- * Classify a variety of foods and suggest if they are healthy choices.
- Compare animals and humans at different stages of their lives.
- * Discuss medicines and the importance of staying healthy.



Homework

Year 2 homework is set every evening to enable the children to consolidate their learning.

This half term homework will include:

- Times table work using multiplication and division facts
- Consolidation of number bonds
- Written methods of working out

- Mental Arithmetic
