Anti-Bullying Week: 10th – 14th November 2025

We do not tolerate any form of bullying at Forest. Therefore, we will be supporting Anti Bullying Week this November.

Anti-Bullying Week is coordinated in England and Wales by the Anti-Bullying Alliance and takes place from 10th to 14th November. It has the theme **Power for Good**. The week will begin with National **Odd Socks Day**, on Monday 10th November, where children can come to school in their choice of odd socks. Those children doing PE on a Monday will be able to wear these socks during their lesson.

The theme of **Power for Good** has been chosen as teachers and children across the country wanted a theme that empowered them to do something positive to counter the harm and hurt that bullying causes.
