Parents and grandparents are asked to arrive at the church between 2:15 and 2:25 pm in order that the service may begin at 2:30 pm. Seating will not be reserved but there will be plenty of seating available. At the end of the service, children should be collected by their parents in the church. Should you wish, there will be a coin collection for the church during the service.
